



Campground Guidelines

Our Staff are committed to keeping your campsite clean and safe. Your cooperation in observing the following guidelines is appreciated and will help make everyone's stay more enjoyable.

1. REGISTRATION:

- Check-in time is 1:00 p.m.
- Check-out time is 11:00 a.m.
- If you plan on staying longer, please re-register by 9:00 a.m. on your check-out date.
- Reservations are taken as a first come/first serve basis. Reservations open April 1st.
- Daily, weekly and monthly rates must be paid upon registration. There are no refunds.
- Stays will be no longer than one month at any given time.
- Campground will be open from May 1st to September 30th.

2. WHILE IN THE PARK

- Quiet time is from 11:00 p.m. to 8:00 a.m.
- No visitors are allowed after 11:00 p.m.
- Our gate is closed at 10:00 p.m. If you leave or enter the park after this time, please close the gate again.
- Management reserves the right to evict anyone causing a disturbance in the park (without refunds), to refuse service to anyone, and will not be responsible for personal property or possessions.
- Children must be supervised in the campground at all times to ensure their safety
- Pets are welcome, but must be on a leash at all times and they are not to be left unattended. Please clean up after your pet. Complementary pet waste stations are located throughout the campground. Barking dogs will not be tolerated.

3. VEHICLES:

- The 15km per hour speed limit throughout the park is strictly enforced.
- Please ensure vehicles do not block the entrance to adjacent sites.
- Servicing and repairing of vehicles in the campground is prohibited.
- Please refrain from driving or parking on the grass and mulch.

4. BARBECUE USE:

- Please do not place live coals from barbecue in garbage bins or dump ashes at your site. Our staff will clean your barbecue pit.
- Firewood is not provided.
- Cutting trees is prohibited.
- No fires permitted after 11:00 p.m.
- Campfires must be in barbecue pits only and kept to a reasonable and safe size.

5. OTHER SERVICES:

- Each site is provided a barbecue pit and picnic table.
- Please do not remove picnic tables from your site.
- Dispose of garbage in containers located within the park. Please do not leave garbage containers at your campsite.
- Our water pressure is very high, a pressure regulator is recommended.
- Dumping of grey or black water at the site is prohibited.
