Sometimes, families need financial assistance to get their kids into a sport or physical activity. Jumpstart is committed to helping all families access a range of activities, from boxing to bowling and skating to skiing, and helps to fund equipment costs as well.

**PURPOSE OF THE GRANT**

The purpose of this grant is to assist in the development and provision of sport, recreation and cultural programs by providing funds to non-profit community organizations operated by volunteers.

The Community Grant Program is guided by the following:

- It provides access to sport, culture and recreation activities for all Saskatchewan people regardless of age, sex, ethnicity, economic status, physical or mental ability.
- It provides funds to community non-profit volunteer organizations in support of sport, culture and recreation programs.
- It allows communities to establish priorities and
- It stipulates that all participating groups, from administration to beneficiary, are responsible for ensuring complete and accurate accounting.

**WHO CAN APPLY?**

To be eligible for support, your organization must:

- Be a volunteer-based organization governed by a volunteer board.
- Be registered as a non-profit corporation federally or with the Corporations Branch, Saskatchewan Justice Department (your application must include documentation showing current non-profit status and your incorporation number).
- Be able to provide appropriate liability and participant insurance for each project.

**ELIGIBLE PROJECTS & PROGRAMS PRIORITIES**

- To be eligible for consideration, your project must focus on increasing participation in sport, culture or recreational activities.
- The majority of the participants must be Warman residents.
- Priority will be given to projects serving economically disadvantaged people, new Canadians, older adults (65 & up), persons with a disability, single parent families, or youth at risk.

## REFUNDS AND CREDITS

• Should we cancel a program due to insufficient enrollment, your preference of a full refund, credit on account, or enrollment in another available program will be made available to you.

• A written refund request that is received seven (7) days prior to the start of a course will receive a 100% refund.

• A 50% refund is issued if cancellation is received less than seven days prior to course start, or if the program has started but is less than 20% complete.

• A prorated refund will be issued for cancellations at any time due to medical reasons (medical certificate required).

The City of Warman has two campgrounds located within the City.

**The Brian King Centre Campground** is located on 9th Ave N and has 7 sites. It is a well-treed campground, all sites are electrified, feature a wood-burning BBQ (wood not provided), and a picnic table. An RV Dump station, washroom, and free showers are located steps away.

**The Prairie Oasis Campground** is located on 3rd Ave S. and has 25 sites. All sites are electrified, have water, a picnic table, and a campfire pit (wood not provided). An RV Dump Station is on-site for your convenience. Washrooms and free showers are also on site.

Campsites at either location can be reserved on-line. All reservations must be paid for at the time of booking. A valid email address is required to make an on-line campsite reservation. Campgrounds are open May to the end of September. Reservations are taken on a first-come/first serve basis. Reservations open on April 1st.

Check-in time is 1:00 p.m. AND Check-out time is 11:00 a.m.



## ART






