

# 2025 Annual City Cleanup

## September 15 - 25

South Side of Central Street  
**ALL items MUST be out by**  
**7:00 AM - Sept 15<sup>th</sup>**  
**Pick up: Sept 15 to Sep 17**

North of Central **and West** of  
 Centennial (Including Centennial)  
**ALL items MUST be out by**  
**7:00 AM - Sept 18<sup>th</sup>**  
**Pick up: Sept 18 to Sept 22**

North of Central **and East** of  
 Centennial  
**ALL items MUST be out by**  
**7:00 AM - Sept 23<sup>rd</sup>**  
**Pick up: Sept 23 to Sept 25**


**\*\*\* Please follow guidelines to ensure items are picked up \*\*\***

- Items must be ready for pickup at **7:00 am** in the back alley on the **first day** shown for your area. Public Works will not go back to pick up items put out after this time.
- Items must be bundled and packaged neatly (bagged or boxed) for quick and efficient pick-up.
- Please separate metal materials from the rest of the garbage, as they will be picked up separately.
- Items must be completely in the alley and off the property, but not hinder back alley traffic. If there is any confusion items will **NOT** be picked up.
- Residents with no back alley will have items picked up on the first day of the cleanup for their area. Please have your items ready by 7:00 am at the end of your driveway.

**Do not place items in your alley prior to *Sept 8th*.**  
**PROPERTIES DOING SO WILL BE SUBJECT TO BYLAW ENFORCEMENT.**

- DO NOT leave any items in the alley that you do not want picked up. The City will not be responsible for any items picked up in error.
- Leaves, garden refuse and grass clippings **must** be bagged. (The compost depot is a better option).
- Tree branches must be **cut in lengths no longer than four feet and tied**. (The compost depot is a better option).
- Carpet must be rolled and **cut to no longer than four feet in length and tied**.
- **Appliances** - will not accept multiples of each per home.
- **Limit - TWO CUBIC YARDS per household** (3 ft x 6 ft x 3 ft).
- **City cleanup is for residential homes only. The City will not pick up items from businesses or institutions.**
- **Items remaining in the alley after City Cleanup are the responsibility of the homeowner to cleanup.**
- **Failure to remove items remaining in the alley after City Cleanup is over will result in the resident being charged a fine of \$200. (Bylaw 2006-01)**

**Items That WILL NOT Be Picked Up:**



- **Materials from major renovations**
- **Drywall, Shingles**
- **Deck boards**
- **Railroad ties & Power poles**
- **Tires**
- **Concrete and rocks**
- **Sod, Tree trunks and logs**
- **Day to day household garbage**
- **Motor oil** (can be taken to any SARRC Eco Centre year round or to HHWD on October 4, limit of 60 L)
- **Toxic materials such as chemicals, gasoline, etc.** (this can be taken to HHWD on October 4)
- **Household Paint** (take to SARCAN)
- **Batteries** (take to SARCAN or HHWD October 4)
- **Leaves and grass not in bags** (can be taken to compost depot)
- **Small Branches not bundled and tied** (can be taken to compost depot)
- **LIMIT OF TWO CUBIC YARDS PER ADDRESS**
